It is one of the most effective tools available for protecting public health in regions where malaria and other insect-borne diseases are present. FENDONA provides highly effective insect control when used as a surface spray or for treating protective nets.



USING FENDONA® AS A SURFACE SPRAY.

FENDONA® can be used to control mosquitoes and other insects by spraying the product on walls and other surfaces where insects land. Unlike many other products, FENDONA works on virtually any surface. Its crystalline particles adhere to bare wood, glass, brick, concrete and masonry.

USING FENDONA TO TREAT NETS.

FENDONA is also highly recommended for use on insecticide treated nets (ITNs). ITNs give individuals the ability to take control of their own well-being, and FENDONA ensures that they'll benefit from safe, dependable control. In addition to eliminating insects through contact and ingestion, FENDONA also has a proven repellent action that keeps insects from getting too close in the first place. FENDONA can be used in the original production of ITNs as well as to re-treat nets using convenient Dip-It-Yourself™ kits that include a 6-ml FENDONA sachet, gloves, a measuring bag and easy-to-follow instructions in written and pictogram form.
